COWAN VILLAGE RULES



Vehicles (including quad bikes) are <u>NOT</u> permitted on the beach unless when genuinely launching or retrieving a vessel. Penalties apply. (QPWS Regulations)



Village speed limit of **2Okph**. **10kph is preferred**. Remember that all Queensland traffic regulations apply on Moreton Island.









Noise can annoy. Consider your neighbours at all times when operating machinery eg. generators, power tools, lawn mowers, outboard motors etc.



Non-residents may not bring ANY animal to the Island. Dogs not contained within a property must be controlled at all times.

(QPWS & BCC Regulations)

Only use established pedestrian tracks to access beach and avoid trespassing. Use of multiple access tracks increases erosion.







NEVER remove vegetation from the public land on the foreshore or dunes. This is critical for the management of erosion and BCC fines can apply.



SPEED LIMIT 6 KNOTS

For all vessels - front of beach safety zone



To avoid serious injuries from water related accidents from boats and jet skis, there is a 6 knot speed limit within the Cowan Cowan Beach Safety Zone. (Qld Maritime Regulations)



NEVER allow children to climb on the beach frontal dunes as it causes erosion. Serious injuries have also been sustained from contact with broken glass, rusted wire and star pickets etc.
